#### Minister's Moment—What Do I Stand For?

When I was in elementary school, every day we would pledge allegiance to the flag. Our entire school would stand at attention, place our hands over our hearts, and then unanimously pledge allegiance. We could have said the same words and even placed our hands over our hearts while sitting but we didn't, why? I think the simple reason is because we want to visibly and unitedly declare honor to what we were participating in and also what it represented, our Nation.

If you are in the military and an officer of superior rank enters the room you stand and salute. When we sing the National Anthem at a ballgame we stand, take off our hats, and place our hands over our hearts. Even at a wedding when the bride enters the auditorium we stand as she walks in. Many of us have even been taught to stand if seated when someone comes over to shake your hand. All of these gesture display honor. They all say that I respect the person or the function I am participating in. Read with me what Nehemiah says in chapter 9.

Nehemiah 9:1-3 - On October 31 the people assembled again, and this time they fasted and dressed in burlap and sprinkled dust on their heads. Those of Israelite descent separated themselves from all foreigners as they confessed their own sins and the sins of their ancestors. They remained standing in place for three hours while the Book of the Law of the LORD their God was read aloud to them. Then for three more hours they confessed their sins and worshiped the LORD their God.

This is the second time in two chapters that Israel has stood at the reading of God's Word, why? Because the wants to show how much they honored God. The reading of God's Word is more than just opening up a self help book with the hope of finding some comfort and direction. Reading God's Word is coming face to face with the Love God has for us, the depth of our sinfulness and helplessness, the unfathomable holiness, perfection, and purity of God, and His call on our life, to name a few. The Bible is not simply a book, it is God's Word to us and it is living and active, as well as having the ability to transform us and empower us. As a Church family we have decided to honor God's Word in a visible way by reading through it completely. We want to proclaim in a tangible way that we love God and we want to listen to what He has to say to us. Reading God's Word through continuously as a Church will hopefully bring a great understanding of the importance it should have in our lives. To give up sleep to come out an read, to read even when we might get a passage with names we can't pronounce, to rearrange our schedule to make a priority out of God, are all ways we are declaring to God, we honor You, love You, and want to be directed by You.

So back to the question, what do I stand for? I hope we can all answer, I stand for God's Word, on God's Word, and with God's Word in everything we do.

Colossians 3:16,17 - Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts. And whatever you do or say, do it as a representative of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through him to God the Father.
