Minister's Moment—Who Do I Say that I Am?

We have been looking at Jesus in our sermon series for the last few weeks. We've been striving to dive deeper in our understanding of who He is but also in our desire to follow Him. I have been challenged as I have prepared these messages; they have revealed and uncovered so many things that I often want to remain covered and hidden. So, this article is about who I say I am, who do I let others see, who do I present before God, who am I present as the true Todd, even if it isn't always true?

I want to look at an interaction Jesus has with the woman at the well. She is most likely an outcast in her community because of the time she has come to the well and also the fact that she is all alone. Jesus has set up an opportunity to not only meet her but to transform her life. However, before the transformation he offers (living water bubbling up within her) there has to come confrontation of who she really is.

John 4:13-18 - Jesus replied, "Anyone who drinks this water will soon become thirsty again. But those who drink the water I give will never be thirsty again. It becomes a fresh, bubbling spring within them, giving them eternal life." "Please, sir," the woman said, "give me this water! Then I'll never be thirsty again, and I won't have to come here to get water." "Go and get your husband," Jesus told her. "I don't have a husband," the woman replied. Jesus said, "You're right! You don't have a husband—for you have had five husbands, and you aren't even married to the man you're living with now. You certainly spoke the truth!"

Here we find Jesus confronting her about the one topic she really would rather avoid, Go get your husband. Think about what Jesus is doing here, He is challenging her to see and accept the truth about her situation. It is at this point that the woman has to make a decision, will I show Him the disguise that I try to pass of to others or will I reveal the truth about myself? She decides to come face to face with the truth (at least partially). I have no husband. Jesus seeing her willingness to start the process of coming clean helps her finish by filling in all of the details. He are right, you've had 5 husbands and are living with a man who you aren't married to, you certainly have spoken the truth. You might see this as a little abusive and uncalled for but it absolutely is not; the only way we can ever be truly transformed is for us to see ourselves for who we truly are.

That is why we need to ask this question of ourselves, who do I say I am? Is our answer aligned with the truth? Are our eyes open to who we really are and what needs we desperately need? Our degree of maturity in Christ is directly proportional to our degree of transparence and vulnerability with Christ. If I am unwilling to uncover my sinfulness, weakness, and flaws before Him how can His grace, mercy, and power cover them?

John 4:39-24 - Many Samaritans from the village believed in Jesus because the woman had said, "He told me everything I ever did!" When they came out to see him, they begged him to stay in their village. So he stayed for two days, long enough for many more to hear his message and believe. Then they said to the woman, "Now we believe, not just because of what you told us, but because we have heard him ourselves. Now we know that he is indeed the Savior of the world."

The result of her vulnerability was not only does she come face to face with the Messiah and get to experience the springs of living water but many others also come face to face with Jesus, the Messiah, and get to enjoy those same springs. All of this is the result of one woman being willing to look at the truth of her own live when she comes face to face with Jesus.

Are we willing to do the same? Will we truthfully answer the question, who do I say that I am? Notice everything changes when we are willing to answer that question, even the answer to that question changes. She is no longer the woman who fails at every relationship, she is now the woman who has an eternal relationship with Jesus and who introduced many others to Jesus as well. If we will honestly answer the question, who do I say that I am, then our answer too can be changed. I am a Child of God!

that Sunday. If you want to participate in any part of this process, see Billy Murphy!




We are starting a new adult Sunday school class in our first hour! The curriculum will be the same as the second hour, The Gospel Project, which is also
