Minister's Moment—Baby, It's Cold Outside!

As the temperatures drop it is easy to get focused on staying in and staying warm. For many you can't even get comfortable without being warm and toasty. So fires in the fireplace, electric blankets, cozy socks, fleece sweatshirts, and hot cocoa or coffee all become a growing priority. As much as you don't like the cold outside, God dislikes the cold inside even more. Listen to how Jesus describes the Last Days.

Matthew 24:9-14 - "Then you will be arrested, persecuted, and killed. You will be hated all over the world because you are my followers. And many will turn away from me and betray and hate each other. And many false prophets will appear and will deceive many people. Sin will be rampant everywhere, and the love of many will grow cold. But the one who endures to the end will be saved. And the Good News about the Kingdom will be preached throughout the whole world, so that all nations will hear it; and then the end will come.

There is so much information that we could look at in these verses but I want us to focus on just one thing; "the love of many will grow cold." As bad as the brutal assault cold temperatures can have on the physical body is, cold hearts of God's people can have the same brutal affect on the body of believers. Think about what it means to have a cold heart: essentially you don't care about those around you, compassion is replaced with self-centeredness, and getting involved to help is not even an option. It is one thing to be physically cold but it is worse by many multitudes to be spiritually cold. Listen to how Jesus addresses the Church in Laodicea. Revelation 3:15-16 - "I know all the things you do, that you are neither hot nor cold. I wish that you were one or the other! But since you are like lukewarm water, neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth!

The same attitude described in Matthew 24 as being cold is described in Revelations 3 as being lukewarm. It is the attitude of not being helpful to others, neither being soothing or refreshing, just being blah. In fact Jesus warns "blah" Christians aren't just ineffective but are so vile He is going to spit them out of His mouth! That is a scary thought, so let's try to end on a happy note.

Yes it is getting cold outside, layered clothing is being to be seen everywhere, but for the Christian we can have a blazing furnace inside because of out love for God and others. We just have to keep stoking that fire, keep fueling our souls, and keep letting our lights shine through deeds of love and service. It may be cold outside, but the Church needs to be blazing with love. So, ask yourself, who needs to experiences the blazing embers of God's love on display through my life? Who needs their insides warmed up and
