Minister's Moment—Speak to Us

Do you ever wish you could hear God's voice guiding you through a situation? God, should I take this job or not? YES. God, should I buy this house or that one? THAT ONE. God, do you want me to speak up or stay silent? SPEAK UP. Yet we all realize that isn't how it works; God speaks to us but not usually through and audible voice blasting down from heaven. (although that is what the disciples heard as they were on the Mt of Transfiguration) God speaks to us through His Spirit and through His Word. Most of the time when the Holy Spirit is nudging me He is reminding me of a verse from God's Word; give with a cheerful heart, seek and save the lost, how can they believe if they haven't heard, and so on and so forth.

2 Timothy 3:16,17 - All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work.

John 16:13,14 - When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own but will tell you what he has heard. He will tell you about the future. He will bring me glory by telling you whatever he receives from me.

Instead of crying out to God wondering why He hasn't spoken to us, maybe the problem is that God is crying out to us through His Spirit and His Word but we aren't listening. We need to not only read God's Word but also meditate on it. We need to read and listen to God's Word which is living and active. We need to allow God's Word to direct our paths and order our steps.

With all that in mind, this month we are going to, as a Church, read through God's Word once again. Last time it took us around 74 hours straight to read it out loud around the clock. We want to read God's Word out loud in its entirety because we believe His Word is Living and that He speaks into all of our circumstances through it. We also want to read through it completely as an act of worship and obedience as we seek to honor God with our lives and listen again to the Love Letter He has written us.

I want to encourage everyone to come out and participate in the reading of God's Word. If you don't feel comfortable reading out loud you can simply come and listen to it being read. The signup sheet is already in the foyer of the Church building awaiting you to choose a time to participate. Join us as we ask again for God to speak through His Word to His People's hearts.
